**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF
WOODLYNNE, AMENDING CHAPTER 116, VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC,
SECTION 116-14 “PARKING PROHIBITED DURING CERTAIN HOURS.**

WHEREAS, Chapter 116 of the Borough of Woodlynne’s Code of Ordinances regulates Vehicles and Traffic; and

WHEREAS, Section 116-14 of the Borough of Woodlynne’s Code of Ordinances restricts parking prohibited during certain hours within the Borough of Woodlynne; and.

WHEREAS, Borough Council desires to amend said Chapter to include a No Parking on Mondays and Wednesdays from 7:am to 3:pm designation on Northside of 3rd Street adjacent to Linden Avenue and Chestnut Ave; and

NOW , THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the governing body of the Borough of Woodlynne in the County of Camden, and State of New Jersey, that Chapter 116, Vehicles and Traffic, Section 116-14, “Parking Prohibited Mondays and Wednesdays from 7:am to 3:pm on the Northside of 3rd street adjacent to Linden Avenue and Chestnut Ave ”, of the Borough of Woodlynne, County of Camden, State of New Jersey be and is amended as follows:

Name of Street	Side	Hours/Days	Location
3 rd Street	North	7:00 am to 3:00 pm Monday/Wednesday	From the west curbline of Linden Avenue to east curbline of Chestnut Avenue thereof.

This ordinance shall take effect upon final adoption and publication in the manner according to law.
